Contributing vs. non-contributing resources: For a historic district, resource group or single parcel with more than one resource, the NRHP listed/eligible boundaries must be identified and the related resources are identified as follows:

- **Contributing resources:** (buildings, structures, etc) that are at least 50 years old and related to the period of significance for the historic district/resource and retain most of their original structure (shape, materials, etc.).
- **Non-contributing resources:** ones that are less than 50 years old, do not relate to the period of significance for the historic district/resource, or that have been modified so much that they do not retain most of their original structure or materials.
